## HAZARD, RISK AND DISASTER REDUCTION: STATE OF THE ART

This talk will review the current state and developing trends in disaster risk reduction and emergency preparedness. It will do so using models of the institutions and processes involved. With regard to both natural and anthropogenic hazards, particular attention will be devoted to the relationship between science and society. In a world characterised by rapid change, disaster preparedness must adapt rapidly and effectively to global and local tendencies.

David Alexander is Professor of Disaster Management at CESPRO, the University of Florence's Centre for Risk and Civil Protection Studies, where he is the principal lecturer in a Master's degree in emergency management. Alexander taught for 22 years in America at the University of Massachusetts and has also taught at various British and Italian universities. He is the author of several books, including Natural Disasters, Confronting Catastrophe and Principles of Emergency Planning and Management.
